





HOUSE RULES

NO SMOKING.
Please keep our hom

Please keep our home smoke free. Smoking is permitted outside on the back patio, ashtray provided. If extra cleaning is needed for smoke odor, a charge will be added to final bill.

SORRY, NO PETS.

No pets allowed including ESAs.

KEEP OUTSIDE SHOES...OUTSIDE.

Please remove shoes when indoors. The orange dirt likes to adhere to white surfaces easily.

OCCUPY HONESTLY.

We screen guests when arriving and entering the property. If more guests enter the property than are listed in the reservation, any extra guests will be required to vacate immediately.

AMENITIES

AIR CONDITIONER & HEATER

Combination A/C & heater units are located in each room. Please conserve energy.

WASHER & DRYER

Washer & dryer on site.

LAKE TOYS

Life vests for 10 are on site. 1 canoe, 2 paddle boards, and 2 kayaks are also on site for guest use. The code to unlock the lake toys is "1373" and specific towels are provided in the laundry for lake use only.

BASEMENT GAME ROOM

Plenty of things for the kids and adults to do. Game table, board games, books, and toys for littles.





BEARS

We have seen a bear on our property so be alert at all times! They especially love digging around in that delicious trash can if left open. Please remember to lock trash cans after each use!

DEER

Enjoy the local deer in the early quiet mornings roaming the property. They tend to stay away during the busy hours of the day, but will appear during quieter times.

WILD TURKEYS

That's right, turkeys galore!

RACOONS & ANIMALS GALORE

Raccoons, opossums, beavers, and critters of all kinds love these woods. Please do not leave any trash or food outside and make sure to lock trash cans after each use.

Bear Wise Volume in bear country, so there's a change you'll see

You are in bear country, so there's a chance you'll see black bears here, even if you never go into the woods.

Don't Feed the Bears

-Don't leave food, trash or pet food outdoors when no one is around. A few seconds is all it takes for a hungry bear to swipe it.

- -Feeding bears or using food to encourage bears to approach you is often illegal and always dangerous.
- -Don't throw scraps or leftovers out the car window or into the woods behind your vacation rental.
- -If trash container or dumpster is full, don't pile trash outside; take it with you when you leave.

Bear Viewing Guidelines

- -Stay in your vehicle; even bears that seem comfortable around people are still wild animals.
- -Never approach bears or entice them to approach you.
- -Enjoy bears from a safe distance. Stay at least 50 yards or 10 car lengths away.
- -Don't block the road to view bears. If permitted, pull over and take photos from the safety of your vehicle. If you want to see bears, early morning and early evening are good times for viewing and photography.

Driving in Bear Country

- -Stay alert, stick to the speed limit and scan the roadsides. If a bear crosses the road, watch for cubs before you drive on.
- -Be especially alert at dawn and dusk when bears are most active; black bears are fast and hard to see.
- -If you hit a bear, don't try to help it. Call 911 or report to authorities as soon as you can.

 Wildlife collisions are not always covered by insurance.



Dogs and bears don't mix. **Keep your dog on a leash at all times when outdoors**. Letting your dog approach or lunge at a bear puts you and your pet in danger.

Discourage Break-Ins

- -Lock vehicles; don't leave windows open even a crack. Remove anything with an odor (food, drinks, trash, pet food, scented products).
- -Keep exterior doors closed, even when you're there.
- -Don't stash food, beverages, trash or recycling on porches/patios/decks.

If You See a Black Bear

-If a bear comes around your place, try to scare it away by making lots of noise yelling or banging pots and pans together from a safe distance.

-If you see a bear near a dumpster or in a building, don't approach or corner it. Give the bear an escape route.

In the Woods

Carry bear spray and know how to use it.

If you see a bear before it notices you, don't approach. Stand still, enjoy, then quietly move away.

If a bear sees you, back away slowly. Never run; running may trigger a chase response.

If a bear approaches, hold your ground, wave your arms and yell "Hey Bear" until it leaves. Always stay with your group. If it keeps approaching, use bear spray.

If a black bear makes contact with you, do NOT play dead; fight back aggressively.

Black bear is a species; common colors include black, brown and cinnamon.

BOATING TIPS

WEAR A JACKET

Anyone on a water-craft or being to

Anyone on a water-craft or being towed must wear a properly-fitting <u>USCG-approved life vest</u> per Virginia regulations.

AVOID CONGESTED AREAS

Avoid towing in congested areas and narrow coves and creeks.

MAINTAIN A SAFE DISTANCE
Minimize repeat passes along the same shorelines. Vary the locations you choose for enjoying tow sports.

Put an end to power turns. Instead, chop the throttle when a rider falls. Then circle back at idle speed to avoid creating rollers that assault shorelines, endanger swimmers and paddlers, and unnecessarily detract from smooth water conditions.

WATCH YOUR TIME
Enjoy towed sports between dawn and dusk as allowed by
Virginia state law (one-half hour before sunrise and one-half hour after sunset).

THINGS TO DO

EXPLORE THE LAKE

Explore the twists and turns of our coveted, less busy part of the lake with our canoes, paddleboards and kayaks. The quiet coves are perfect for relaxing and exploring.

BRIDGEWATER MARINA

Take a drive or a boat ride down to North Shore and explore the Bridgewater Marina shops and restaurants.

MCAFEE KNOB

Considered one of the most <u>scenic spots</u> in all of Roanoke, <u>McAfee Knob</u> sits along a Virginia stretch of the Appalachian Trail.

MILL MOUNTAIN PARK

10 miles of trails with two incredible mountain overlooks. Sitting on a mountaintop, a 100-foot-tall star lights up in neon; its colors change throughout the year to match particular seasons or occasions.

PLACES TO SEE



BLUE RIDGE MOUNTAIN PKWY

If you love taking drives through beautiful scenery then this is the drive for you. The Blue Ridge Mountain Parkway is minutes away from the house.



SMITH MOUNTAIN LAKE

Explore all the fingers and coves of SML with your own personal boat or a rental boat from Bridgewater Marina.



CITY MARKET

This open-air market is the oldest, continuous operation of its kind in Virginia. Activities including the annual chili cook-off and monthly Art by Night, as well as local produce make it a popular spot.



PINBALL MUSEUM & STARCADE

Over 55 playable machines with production dates ranging from the 1930's to the present day. Starcade is an interactive museum with more than 3,000 arcade games available to play.

LOCAL RESTAURANTS

BRUNO'S CLUBHOUSE

The first restaurant we ate at while visiting our lakehouse. The pizza was top of the line Italian style pizza. Variety of menu and excellent food.

BLACK WATER CAFE

Prime rib, burgers, crab fries and many other delicious options are available here.

Their second shop just opened near SML and they offer breakfast options, cold and hot sandwiches for lunch with custom options.
